




Campus signage to help direct visitors and members!










In addition, that spreadsheet includes details of the twenty-four (24) most important items identified for future Attention:

- 1. A sound system replacement for our sanctuary with a new audio-visual system for broadcasting our services
- 2. Repairing and/or replacing sections of the roofs on our three buildings
- 3. Bathroom repairs, renovations, and reconfigurations
- 4. Updating our internet connections and TV projection systems in the sanctuary, fellowship hall, offices, and Room 6
- 5. Refreshing the paint, carpet, and furnishings of the nursery, fellowship hall, offices and classrooms
- 6. Repairing damaged building structures, stucco, and drain systems
- 7. Painting our church buildings
- 8. Refreshing our irrigation systems and landscaping

Accomplishing these goals will take time, resources, dedication, vision, and our whole church.



Our goal: \$400,000 to be raised and invested over the coming three fiscal years: 2020-2023.

Three rules will govern our efforts going forward on these projects:

- The Church Council will be responsible to rank capital projects based on their assessment of needs at FLC;
- 2) The Council will be responsible to get bids and estimates on all work, and will serve as the contracting agent for all such work on behalf of FLC;
- Projects will commence only when funding or firm commitments for expenses have been secured from church members or other contributors.
